Abchurch Lane:

A historic lane located just behind the famous St Mary Abchurch, rebuilt by Sir Christopher Wren in 1681, and accessible from Cannon Street and King William Street. This little London lane was once famous for its cake shops and after that, it gained great popularity as the place in London to sample authentic French cuisine.

The Club's origins:

At the beginning of 1843 the City of London Commercial Club closed and in March of the same year the foundation for the Gresham Club was laid in the same place. In 1913, it was paid to vacate these premises and a new building was constructed in 1915 in Abchurch Lane by William Campbell Jones, as a purpose built home for the members of the Gresham Club. In 1993, after 150 years, the committee of the Gresham Club decided to close the Club and the freehold interest of the Club building was acquired by the CCA Group, a professional international club management company. After extensive renovation, the Club re-opened in September 1994 as the London Capital Club, officiated by the Lord Mayor Sir Paul Newall.



Today:

The London Capital Club is an exclusive private club catering to the modern business professional, with a reputation for excellence and personal service. It is a reputation firmly based on preserving the most worthwhile aspects of a traditional City Club, whilst responding to the demands of today's business life.

The London Capital Club is an ideal venue for business meetings, presentations, product launches, social functions and fine dining for 2 to 150 guests. Guests have privileged access to the amenities of six private rooms, wireless internet and an excellent restaurant, Tavern Steak & Oyster. The 1,400 square metres of the Club are spread generously over six floors.

Operated by CCA International and part of International Associate Clubs (IAC), members of the London Capital Club will benefit from access to 250 beautiful venues, golf resorts and private members' clubs on all five continents.






The Oriental Room






The Walbrook




The Boardroom




The Gresham


